# Procedural Checklist for Opening a Business in the Town of Superior

We are excited that you are starting a business in the Town of Superior! The Town is dedicated to helping businesses have a positive experience as they get established. Before opening a business in the Town of Superior, you must complete the following steps.

## **Town Requirements**

#### Interested in opening your business in Superior? Email the Town's Economic Development Manager.

- This enables the Town to connect you with resources that may be helpful to your business launch.
- Please include your name, phone number, and proposed business name, type, and location (if known), business hours of operation, and website.

## Apply for a Business License and any additional permits required by your business.

- Business License Application Form.
- Exempt businesses: Nonprofits and businesses without a physical presence, or only an incidental physical presence, in the Town.
- Verify if you need any other permits.
  - **Sign Permits:** Direct questions to the Planning & Building Department. *Downtown has sign requirements that differ from the Town-wide requirements.*
  - Liquor License: contact the Town Clerk.

### Obtain permits for any alterations to your unit/building.

- Permits must be pulled electronically through the Town's permit portal: <u>CommunityCore</u>.
- Contact Building Department to determine if you require any building permits.

### Contact Utility Billing to set up an account and let them know the date you want to start services.

• Superior's utilities for commercial customers may include water, sewer, and storm water.

## **State Requirements**

**Register your business with the Colorado Secretary of State's office.** 

• Forms are available on the Secretary of State's website.

### If you are a state-regulated entity, apply for a license with the Department of Regulatory Agencies.

• <u>DORA's website</u> provides a full list of industries and professions regulated by DORA's Divisions, along with the links to look up a license, check for discipline, file a complaint and more.

#### Appoint a Colorado Registered Agent.

- Every business is required by state law to appoint and maintain a Colorado registered agent on record with the Secretary of State.
- More information can be found at <u>Registered Agent</u> <u>FAQ's.</u>
- Registered agent information can be updated when filing periodic reports.

### File Formation Documents with the Secretary of State.

- Business Documents can be found on the <u>Secretary of</u>
  <u>State's website</u>.
- Documents come with a \$50 filing fee.

# If applicable, contact the Secretary of State and the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office for information on state and federal trademarks and copyright.

• The Secretary of State provides <u>answers to frequently</u> <u>asked questions regarding Trademarks</u>.

#### If applicable, contact the Colorado Office of Economic Development & International Trade to apply for incentives or tax credits.

• <u>Available</u> to businesses who align with programmatic criteria.
