



Town of Superior Business and Non-Profit Event Marketing Policy

July 2026

This policy guides the Town of Superior's marketing efforts and opportunities related to local business events to ensure transparency, fairness, and consistency in supporting our entire business community.

1. Objective

- Promote positive and fair representation of all local businesses and non-profits.
- Support growth and community engagement for businesses and non-profits.
- Clarify the use of Town resources and channels in support of business and non-profit events and business and non-profit related events.

2. Business and Non-Profits Events Marketing Policy

The information below outlines the Town's policy on marketing opportunities for business and non-profit events and business and non-profit related events:

- The Town of Superior will not share business or on-profit event information or event ads via the Town's social media, via direct email, or via other electronic means.
- Town of Superior businesses and non-profits are welcome to post event information in the form of flyers on the following boards:
 - **Community Board:** The Town has two Community Boards, one located in the Superior Community Center and one located in the Superior Civic Space. Businesses and non-profits may post event information on the Community Boards so long as the event is **free and available to the public**.
 - **Business Board:** The Town has one Business Board, located in the Superior Civic Space. This board allows for businesses to post business events, ticketed events, sales, highlights, etc. in accordance with the Business Board policies, found on the Town's [Business Resources webpage](#).
- The Town of Superior will, when appropriate, work with businesses and non-profits for Town events, with the business or non-profit being an event partner or sponsor. In these situations, the Town of Superior will market the event information primarily, and highlight the business, non-profit, sponsor, or partner secondarily to ensure the primary focus of



the marketing efforts are event related communications. All event partnerships and sponsorships covered by this policy will be managed by the Town of Superior's Events team.

- This policy will be updated as needed to reflect evolving best practices and community needs.
